# STORY CONTEST RULES

### PURPOSE:

The purpose of this contest is to bring a connection of Utah's agriculture from the farm to the plate and foster student creativity.

#### **CONTEST THEME:**

"Agriculture: We eat it, we wear it, we live it."

#### CATEGORIES:

- 3rd Grade
- 7th & 8th Grade
- 4th Grade
- 9th-12th Grade
- 5th Grade
- Adults over 18
- 6th Grade

## CONTENT:

Story should be a true to life and may be illustrated.

## REQUIREMENTS:

- Not to exceed 1,000 words.
- Typed double-spaced, or neatly hand-written.
- Front page should include contestant's name, address, phone number, grade level, teacher's name, school name, county and guardian's name.

#### **ENTRY DEADLINES:**

The first place county winners in each of the categories must be forwarded to the Utah Farm Bureau for entry in the state contest by April 1, 2021.\*
County deadlines are set by the County Women's Leadership Chair.

#### JUDGING:

- 50% Content (creativity, accurate agriculture facts, use of the theme)
- 40% Structure (grammar, punctuation, spelling)
- 10% Neatness and form

Each county contest will be judged by a committee of qualified, local people with knowledge of the subject. The County Farm Bureau Women's Chair is responsible for overseeing county judging.

The state contest will be judged by qualified individuals selected by the state Women's Committee.

Decision of the judges will be final.

\*All entries become property of Utah Farm Bureau. No state entries will be returned.
